Itinerary:

8.20 am For an 8.30am Departure by coach from GBG Gate 3 carpark (Eastern Park Circuit).

Frogmore Gardens and Nursery, Wombat Hill Botanic Gardens (with talk and mini tour by their Friends), lunch around Daylesford or the Gardens at your leisure then home via Blackwood Ridge Nursery and Garden then a picnic afternoon tea by the Lerderderg River. Each place is unique. Frogmore specialises in border perennials, plants for prairie gardens and varieties for cut-flowers. Wombat Hill Botanic Gardens hark back to the Gold Rush, with many towering trees, avenues and specialty nooks. Blackwood Ridge is a garden and plant collector's nursery which specialises in rare Japanese Maples, Rhododendrons and other rare collectable ornamental garden plants.

Afterwards, we'll stop for afternoon tea at Blackwood Picnic Area on the Lerderderg River – a place to enjoy the kookaburras, river and beautiful natural surroundings.
