You may think that spring and summer are the seasons for flowers, but many plants are not deterred by the winter chill. Visit the Camellia Walk to see **Azaleas, Camellias and and Fried Egg Plant *Gordonia axillaris*** in flower. There are more than 50 species and varieties of Camellias in these gardens. Camellias and Gordonia are in the plant family Theaceae. This family is named for its most valuable *Camellia*, the Tea bush. Camellias have been grown in China and Japan for centuries
