

Garden Highlights, May 2021



Wintersweet *Chimonanthus praecox* has been cultivated in its native China for 1,000 years. It is valued for the sweet fragrance of its small flowers. You can't miss the perfume on a calm, cool day when the bush is in full bloom. In China, prunings are dried and kept to perfume linen cupboards. This plant is listed as Vulnerable to becoming extinct in the wild.

National Botanic Gardens Day: Tours and other activities, Friends Nursery open. Sunday 30 May 10:00 am - 3:00 pm, Free.

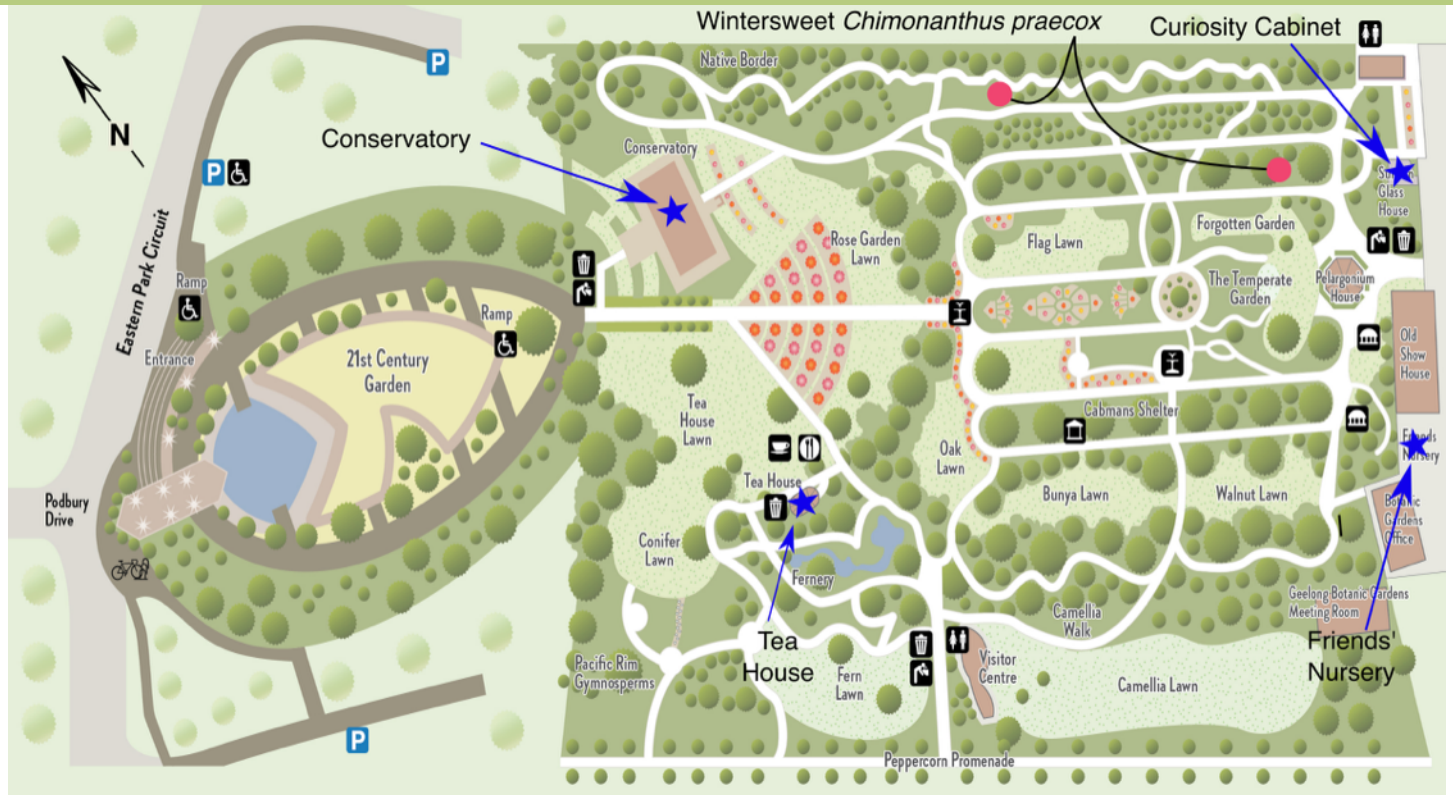
